This is a two-part session, where we start off by looking at the difference between microdata and aggregate data. Then we provide an overview of the DLI including how to search for datasets and accessing data and metadata, using examples such as the Canadian Community Health Survey. The second part, introduces users to the basics of mapping research data including what software, training and help are available at Laurentian University.

Ms. Sylvie Lafortune is the Government Information and Data Librarian at Laurentian University. She has been with the J.N. Desmarais Library for the last 20 years.
