He has conducted research on suicide and mental health care in the Nishnawbe-Aski First Nations of northern Ontario in collaboration with researchers from the School of Nursing (Lakehead), First Nations and Inuit Health Branch (Health Canada), and the Nishnawbe-Aski Nation. He is currently involved in research examining continuity of care issues for children with special needs in rural and remote areas.

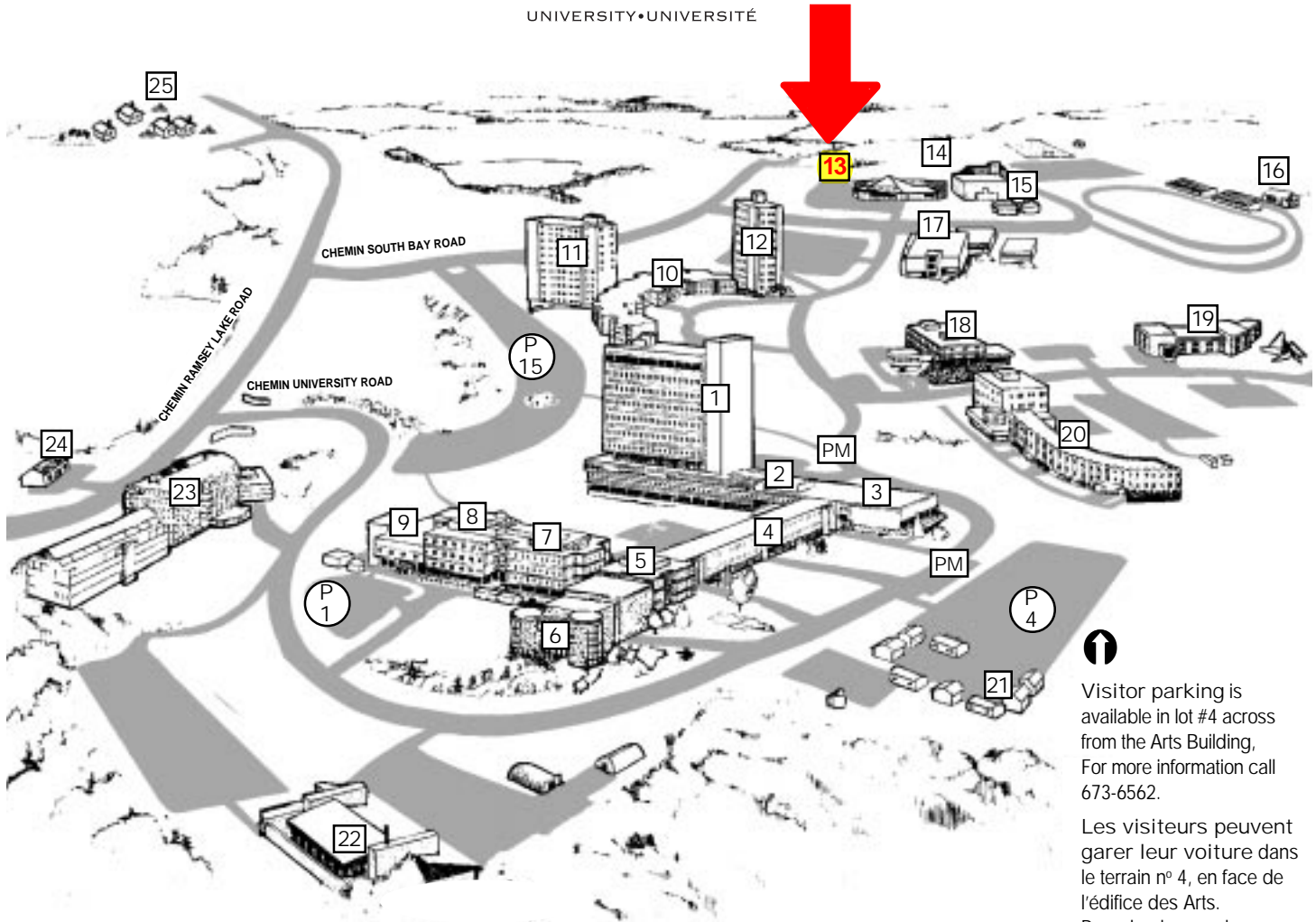
