**Dr. Laura Sky**

Producer/Director, Sky Works Charitable Foundation

***“Real Work for Real Change: The Ethics of Inclusion, Context and Contradictions in Media and Medical Research and Practice”***

The presentation will explore the values, beliefs, stereotypes and unexamined contextual frameworks inherent in the traditional theories and applications of medical ethics. Transposing these values on the structures of media practices proves challenging. The ethics of informed consent, truth telling, paternalism, confidentiality and disclosure autonomy/self determination inform both the participation and exclusion of Aboriginal people, women, newcomers and people living in poverty.

In 1983, after eight years at the National Film Board, **Laura Sky** established Toronto's Sky Works Charitable Foundation and began her career as an independent film director and producer. Laura's work is widely known and acknowledged both here at home and throughout the world as evidenced by the many awards and citations her films have received. She has taught film at Queen's, York, and Ryerson Polytechnic Universities and has lectured extensively throughout Canada, and in Germany and Sweden. Laura has also worked as a free-lance journalist and researcher for both radio and television current affairs programs. In June 2004, Laura received an Honorary Doctorate of Letters from Laurentian University for her achievements as "one of Canada's most distinguished documentary filmmakers". In 1986 she received a Woman of Distinction award from the YWCA of Metropolitan Toronto for her contribution to arts and letters. A socially committed creative artist, Laura Sky has made her personal vision of film making a vibrant and popular reality.
