“Gender and Place in Seniors’ Photovoice Accounts of Health Barriers and Resources in Northwestern Ontario”

Photovoice is a qualitative research technique which is increasingly used to provide a broader range of voices and visions in discussions about the current and prospective health of individuals and communities. This presentation will describe the use of photovoice in a collaborative study of the social and health promotions needs of seniors in two rural northwestern Ontario communities (B. Leipert, M.K. Kelley and P. Wakewich). The significance of ‘place’ as both a health barrier and resource, and the role of gender in shaping the senior men’s and women’s engagement with photovoice method will be highlighted. The value of photovoice as a tool for empowerment and community engagement will be explored.

Pamela Wakewich is Professor of Sociology and Women’s Studies, Site Director (Lakehead University) of the OTC Health Sciences and Policy Research Program and a cross-appointment in Human Sciences at NOSM. She completed her PhD in Sociology at the University of Warwick, U.K. Her research interests include gender, body and health in rural and northern communities, the use of innovative qualitative methods for health research, and transitions in social ideologies of health over time. With colleagues from University of Western Ontario and University of Toronto she is currently exploring discourses on biological risk, gendered responsibility, and young women’s and men’s decision-making about HPV vaccination in Ontario.
